

REPORT FROM THE INTERNATIONAL OFFICE - 2011 ACTIVITIES

"The mission of IPPS, with a focus on the global community of those involved in horticultural plant production, is to share knowledge, information, and skills; to provide guidance and support for lifelong career achievements; to increase recognition of the profession; and to maximize the integration of research, education, and horticultural knowledge."

During 2011, the International Board of Directors continued its new commitment to embrace technology that will help advance the mission of IPPS. The Board not only held its usual meeting of the International Board in conjunction with the International Tour and Regional Conference in Australia in May, but also conducted business via telephone conference in March, September, and November.

Volume 57 of the *Combined Proceedings* was added to the PubHort website as members continued to take advantage of the ability to view abstracts from papers compiled in those 57 volumes, and to download up to ten papers during the year with no additional charges. They can, of course, download more than the complimentary papers for the same small fee paid by those who are not members of IPPS. The PubHort website, managed by the International Society for Horticultural Science (ISHS) will continue to be updated each year and Volumes 58 and 59 will be added to the site in 2012.

Volume 60 of the *Combined Proceedings* was unable to be completed until late fall, but was distributed to all members in book and/or CD formats by year-end. Libraries around the world continue to purchase copies to keep their collections up to date. Members and non-members continue to be able to purchase back issues of the Proceedings as long as inventory lasts.

MEMBERSHIP

Overall membership in IPPS dropped only 2% in 2011, with regions reporting on June 1 as follows:

The newly developed At-Large Member continues to attract individuals from various areas of the world – from countries outside the geographic scope of the current regions. Future development of this option is expected.

A new activity for 2011 was the launch of an International Newsletter, bringing together the news of regions to share with all members around the world. Greg McPhee, International President, and his wife Lyndy, volunteered to develop and produce the newsletter for the next year or so, with assistance from others. Distribution will come from the Regional Secretary-Treasurers' offices and the periodic issues will also be posted on the IPPS website.

Funds set aside in a Travel Scholarship Fund were refined into an IPPS Exchange Program in 2011. Guidelines and procedures were prepared for regions to follow in obtaining grants to support the exchange of members from one region to another for short visits, and participation in regional conferences. The information was sent to Regions and is also posted on the IPPS website.

The International Board also took action to approve a policy and procedures for regions to follow in hosting the International Tour and International Board Meeting. The goal of the policy and structure is 1) to make the Tour more cost-effective for International Board members, particularly when supported by regional budgets, and 2) to shorten the time commitment for International Board members but allow maximum interaction with the region's members at their conference.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2011 INTERNATIONAL BOARD MEETING

On May 23 and 26, 2011 the International Board of Directors met in Kiama and Sydney, New South Wales, Australia with Greg McPhee presiding at the meeting. All eight regions were represented. Again taking advantage of available technology, the International Secretary-Treasurer participated in the meeting via webcam and was able to report and record minutes through that link as well as tape-recorded input, saving IPPS thousands of dollars in travel costs for that individual.

Highlights of the meeting are as follows:

- Minutes of the March 2011 conference call Board meeting were approved.
- Activities of the International Office were reviewed, including the reported levels of staff time needed to manage the IPPS international operations.
- Year-end membership for 2010 was recorded at 1,787 from all regions, a decrease of 152 in the reported numbers compared to the previous year.
- Nine at-large memberships were acknowledged as of this date in 2011 some were "rolled over" for the full year because they joined and paid membership dues late in 2010.
- Five-year membership plaques were being distributed to members for 2011, as requested by the regions.
- Financial reports through almost four months of the fiscal year, April 22, 2011, were reviewed, Investments reported as of March 31, 2011 were also reviewed.

- Calculations for dues income and the cost of operations as well as the costs to produce the Combined Proceedings in book and CD formats were reviewed. The Board reconfirmed previous action to increase basic membership dues paid to International by \$3.00 an increase to \$33 per person USD for 2012.
- With the 2011 budget approved with another operating loss expected, the Board took action to plan an increase in basic dues of \$5.00 for 2013, as a way to bring income closer to the actual cost of operations.
- The International Editor presented reports regarding publication of Volume 59 distributed in September of 2010, and Volume 60 expected to be mailed in September of 2011, with fewer books and CDs anticipated due to declining membership. In 2010, there were 22% of members who do not receive the Proceedings at all with their memberships; however, ALL members now have access to the Proceedings on the PubHort website and the ten free downloads of full papers.
- Although considered as a cost-saving possibility, the Board took action to retain the front section of the Proceedings, retaining the leadership and historical information from each region,
- Reports from the various Regions, presented by their Directors, were reviewed.
- The Education Committee was charged with developing recommendations on how to best utilize the funding set aside for the IPPS Travel Scholarship, stimulating more interest in having members exchange experiences by traveling to other regions. The Board will review the recommendations at its September conference call meeting.
- Plans to implement an international newsletter were undertaken by David Cliffe and Greg McPhee for a one-year period, as a way to launch this project with minimal cost to IPPS.
- The Board agreed to retain the current structure of International Office support from the Heuser Group, and appointed a committee to develop a plan for eventual transition of the editor's responsibilities when the current Editor decides to retire.
- The policy and procedures for the newly developed schedule for the International Tour and International Board Meeting was approved for regions to follow, with flexibility on the days of the week to accommodate typical regional conference schedules.
- The recipient of the Award of Honor for 2012 was identified and approved.
- Preliminary plans for the 2012 International Tour in Japan were reviewed.
- The Finance Committee reviewed information regarding the editorial preparation costs needed to prepare the papers for publication in the book or CD format, as well as for the PubHort website. The Board took action to initiate a cost recovery process by spreading the editorial preparation costs among all members as part of the basic dues structure, recoverable over a three-year period. Detailed information about the costs and the plans for recovery will be reviewed by the Board and also shared with members later this year.
- Two more conference call meetings of the International Board of Directors were arranged for September and December, with possible webcam technology as well as telephone conferencing to be utilized.
- The Board heard a presentation by Dr. Jian Huang of China regarding their activity in establishing a China Society of Plant Propagation and interest in becoming a region of IPPS. Appreciation was expressed, along with the suggestion that more individuals from China become at-large members of IPPS to reach a threshold where regional status can again be considered.
- The Board took action to require all regions to arrange for their websites to be hosted on their own servers, separate from the IPPS main website after an infection in the main site created serious problems for the main website functioning.
- There was agreement that more lead time is needed for planning the International Tour in conjunction with regional conferences, particularly since the International

Tour and Board meeting requires a two-week commitment from attendees. To avoid conflicts with regional conferences, Directors were asked to be prepared to bring to the International Board Meeting their dates for regional conferences for the next three years, so the tour can be scheduled by the hosting region ahead of those dates without conflict.

International President Greg McPhee and Director David Cliffe of the Australian Region facilitated the development of a wonderful International Tour that began in Melbourne and continued through almost 2,000 kilometers in the south east part of Australia, finishing in Sydney for the Region's conference. We always appreciate how much work and planning is required to put these tours together. Our thanks go not only to the more visible leaders, but also to the IPPS members who help out with various tasks, to the Regional Secretary-Treasurer (Pam Berryman) for office support, to the representatives of the nurseries and other tour stops who take time for gracious interaction with the tour participants.
