

## REPORT FROM THE INTERNATIONAL OFFICE – 2013 ACTIVITIES

"The mission of IPPS, with a focus on the global community of those involved in horticultural plant production, is to share knowledge, information, and skills; to provide guidance and support for lifelong career achievements; to increase recognition of the profession; and to maximize the integration of research, education, and horticultural knowledge."

During 2013, the International Board of Directors took substantive action to preserve the members' investment in IPPS through a major shift in cost containment, specifically related to the production and distribution of the *Combined Proceedings* in book and CD formats. After extensive review and discussion, the International Board in early March approved two agreements with the International Society for Horticultural Science (ISHS). One five-year agreement continues the archiving of papers from *Proceedings* on the PubHort website but with a decreased annual fee plus a fee per unique user that would substantially reduce the cost to IPPS. In addition, IPPS members for 2014 were given the additional benefit of downloading unlimited numbers of papers at no cost, in exchange for no longer having access to free downloads of papers from the Acta collection of papers.

The second agreement authorizes ISHS to prepare, publish, and distribute the *Combined Proceedings* in book and CD formats, using final edited materials submitted by the International Editor. The proposal from ISHS to provide this service was substantially lower than IPPS costs, because of the extensive publishing that ISHS already undertakes.

While the typical editing, layout, and review process is taking place, a new member benefit allows members to view from the Members Only area of the IPPS website the papers from each regional conference shortly after they are submitted by the Regional Editors. That meant members could view presented papers – in formats not fully edited -- within about four months of the conferences.

Usage reports for the PubHort website were provided as follows:

2010: 149 papers downloaded by 41 unique users\*
2011: 252 papers downloaded by 72 unique users\*
2012: 226 papers downloaded by 69 unique users\*
2013: ??? papers downloaded by 120 unique users\*

With the new agreement in place, Volume 62 was published in book format by ISHS and distributed in December to members, along with the production of a CD format to be

distributed by the International Office. Volume 61 was uploaded to the PubHort website, bringing the collection up to date.

The Board conducted business via telephone conference calls during the year, and held its International Board Meeting in conjunction with the International Tour held in the Western Region in late September and early October.

Late in 2013, the Region of Great Britain and Ireland informed the Board that their Region is changing its name to the European Region of IPPS, to allow more membership development in countries beyond the United Kingdom.

### **MEMBERSHIP**

Overall membership in IPPS decreased by 5% in 2013, with regions reporting as of June 1 as follows:

In 2013, three regions took advantage of the offer to assist in subsidizing Exchange Programs between regions. Southern Region, USA and the Region of Great Britain and Ireland facilitated an exchange, with partial support from International funds. New Zealand Region and the Region of Japan also facilitated an exchange, with support to the Japan Region as requested. More support is available for future exchanges, particularly between regions who have not yet engaged in this unique learning opportunity.

Of major significance was the decision by the International Board to establish a Strategic Advisory Committee, collecting input from members and regions about IPPS needs and opportunities, for discussion during the 2014 International Board Meeting in South Africa. More information is outlined below in the highlights from the 2013 International Board Meeting.

At the end of 2013, the current International Secretary, Patricia E. Heuser, resigned from that position to enter retirement. The International Board entered into a new contract arrangement with Terri Breon of Breon Consulting to assume the responsibilities of the International Secretary and management of the International Office.

### HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2013 INTERNATIONAL BOARD MEETING

On September 30 and October 1, 2013, the International Board of Directors met in Silverton and Portland, Oregon, USA with David Cliffe presiding at the meeting. All eight regions were represented and minutes of the meeting were taken by the International Secretary via telephone conference, supported by tape recording during the meeting.

### Highlights from the meeting are as follows:

- Minutes of the September 9/10 2013 conference call Board meeting were approved as previously distributed.
- Regional Secretary-Treasurers were acknowledged for providing up-to-date information about regional conferences for the website.
- The indexes of the past Combined Proceedings will continue to be posted on the IPPS website, but will be linked from the PubHort website.
- Student members are being reported by the regional Secretary-Treasurers to the International Office to be given access to the free downloads of IPPS papers on PubHort.
- The Board will continue to monitor the feasibility of having IPPS facilitate the publishing of what has been the Journal of Environmental Horticulture previously published by the American Nursery and Landscape Association.
- Received the report from the International Office with the following points:
  - Staff time invested through 8 months this year is 229.75 hours and is expected to end the year at about 350 hours.
  - Membership for 2013 totals 1535 members, a decrease of 93 members from last year.
  - All except two regions have received their five-year membership plaques to distribute.
  - Regional calendars of events were updated.
  - Website usage was reported in a series of statistics, by month and by page viewings.
  - There will be 830 books and 430 CDs ordered of Volume 62, another decrease from last year.
  - Over eight months, there have been 44 books of various volumes ordered by libraries.
  - The "in memoriam" report was reviewed for any additions.
- The IPPS Linked In social media site, monitored by Alan Jones, has over 1200 participants, although the number of members vs. non-members is unable to be determined, and there will likely be an evaluation of the best use of social media sites.
- The Treasurer's Report included the following highlights:
  - Year-end revenue is anticipated to be about \$20,000 more than operating costs, thanks to the savings in publishing costs.
  - Membership dues will be about \$2,400 less than budgeted because of the drop in membership numbers.
  - The value of investments dropped .8% due to declines in the bond market in the USA; the broker will be consulted for advice on any changes needed in the investment guidelines being followed.

- The International Editor's Report indicates late December or January 2014 as the anticipated mailing date for Volume 62 books and CDs, due to the lateness in the Board's agreement with ISHS to publish the volume.
- For 2013 to date, there have been 236 papers downloaded from the PubHort site by 63 unique IPPS users.
- In 2014, the new agreement with ISHS will allow all IPPS members unlimited downloads of papers from the IPPS website, giving up free access to free downloads of papers on the ACTA website.
- All Regional Directors provided updates of activities within their regions. These are posted on the IPPS website as they are submitted to the International Office.
- Membership dues for 2014 will remain the same as this year, and Chair David Cliffe will send a letter to all IPPS members explaining the Board's reasoning about not changing dues levels for the new year.
- The IPPS website will be redesigned, with input from the Board members, based on cost estimates to be developed by the Marketing Committee. Regions will maintain autonomy but will be asked to conform as much as possible to a format consistent with the international website design.
- IPPS will develop educational materials, like videos posted on YouTube, for distribution from the IPPS website. The Marketing Committee will develop the plans and costs estimates to implement this activity.
- All newsletters produced by a Region will be submitted to the International Office for distribution to all members, as a way to maintain continual communication with members and remind them of their international affiliation.
- A new ad-hoc Strategic Advisory Committee has been formed with Mike Norris as Chair (European Region), Hans Sittig (Southern Africa Region), and Philip Smith (New Zealand Region) to formulate a plan for the future of IPPS and bring their recommendations to the next International Board Meeting in March in South Africa for discussion. In their deliberations, the Committee will consider the following areas:
  - The feasibility and process for soliciting sponsorships from large companies with international interests to support the International Society activities, with an outline of benefits to the sponsors.
  - Ways in which IPPS can embrace the technology of the current age and future, including all aspects of web-based communication, visibility, and sharing information from conferences.
  - Ways in which IPPS can communicate from International directly to members, i.e., an international newsletter, email broadcasting, etc. to maintain ongoing visibility with all members.
  - Options for use of the Exchange Program to maximize involvement of young people in exchanges among six-pack groups, and for participation in international tours.
  - Succession planning for development of officers, especially the International Chair and the International Treasurer, and plans for their orientation to those roles.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  The feasibility of initiating a certification program within IPPS.

- The Chair will communicate with members the intent to continue producing the Proceedings in book and CD format in the immediate future, with an annual review by the Board of the agreement with ISHS for publication options.
- The Board approved entering into a one-year contract with Breon Consulting as of January 1, 2014 to assume responsibilities as the International Secretary of IPPS.
- The nomination of an individual to receive the International Award of Honor in South Africa in 2014 was approved by the Board.
- The newly named European Region (formerly Great Britain & Ireland) has video-taped their conference as a trial of posting conference presentations on the website and is seeking some financial support from the International Board to make this a global trial activity. The Finance Committee is reviewing the request.
- The Board supported the change in name of the Region of Great Britain and Ireland to the European Region, to facilitate membership recruitment and involvement from the geographic countries that comprise Europe.
- Waived the bylaws restriction on a one-year term for the Treasurer to allow Alan Jones to serve a second year in this period of transition to a new International Secretary, and elected him to the Treasurer's position for 2014.
- Elected David Cliffe to a third year as Chair for 2014, and waived the bylaws to allow him to be a candidate for a further year in 2015 to facilitate the transition toward whatever new initiatives the Board approves in 2014.
- Elected Hans Sittig as President for 2014, with Southern Africa hosting the International Tour that year.
- Agreed to hold an election later this year for the position of Vice President since the Southern Region will decide on that individual in November.
