Babylonstoren

Babylonstoren is one of the oldest Cape Dutch farms, set at the foot of in the Franschhoek wine valley. It has a fruit and vegetable garden of beauty and diversity, fine food and wine, and evokes a sense of wellbeing.

The garden comprises 15 clusters spanning vegetable areas, stone and pome fruits, nuts, citrus, berries, bees, herbs, ducks and chickens, a prickly pear maze, and more. Gravity feeds water from a stream by rills into the garden, flowing through ponds planted with edible lotus, nymphaea lilies and waterblommetjies.
