



## REPORT FROM THE INTERNATIONAL OFFICE – 2014 ACTIVITIES

***"The mission of IPPS, with a focus on the global community of those involved in horticultural plant production, is to share knowledge, information, and skills; to provide guidance and support for lifelong career achievements; to increase recognition of the profession; and to maximize the integration of research, education, and horticultural knowledge."***

During 2014, the International Board of Directors continued its focus on efforts on how to sustain and grow the organization's membership by providing the services important to the members. Based on a membership survey at the end of 2013, the Strategic Review Committee analyzed and prioritized themes they were seeing that members wanted from the Society. From that effort, the Board moved to develop a new website, adjust membership categories and restructure the International Board and the roles of its Directors to improve its effectiveness. The membership also noted the lack of communication from International.

The Board recognized that keeping in the forefront of its members is absolutely essential to having engaged members, and keeping them. The development of a new website, which includes creating a consistent face to IPPS and its regions through common graphics and presentation look, is of paramount importance. Significant functionality upgrades will aid members to be engaged with one another, research information quickly, be informed of the Society's activities...and be able to access the site by numerous methods, including, smartphones and I pads. The Regions' websites will be included within the website structure, to create a seamless, easy to navigate, easy to maintain communication tool throughout the Society. The website will be active in February 2015.

IPPS is now in its second year of utilizing the publishing services of the International Society for Horticultural Science (ISHS) to print and distribute the book and CD forms of the *Proceedings*, while continuing to post all the papers on their PubHort website. IPPS members continued to receive up to one thousand free downloads of papers and over 1400 members arranged to have an account to download papers. The following use of the PubHort website was reported:

*2010: 149 papers downloaded by 41 unique users\**  
*2011: 252 papers downloaded by 72 unique users\**  
*2012: 226 papers downloaded by 69 unique users\**  
*2013: 475 papers downloaded by 120 unique users\**  
*2014: 977 papers downloaded by 150 unique users\**

The International Board held its annual meeting in conjunction with the International Tour and Regional Conference in South Africa in March, and continued to conduct business via telephone conferences during the year.

Volume 63 of the *Combined Proceedings* was completed and distributed to all members in December. Distribution included 750 books and 385 CD's. About 50 libraries around the world continue to purchase copies to keep their collections up to date.

## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2014 INTERNATIONAL BOARD MEETING

On March 1 and 5, 2014, the International Board of Directors met in Randburg and at Kloofzicht Lodge, South Africa, with David Cliffe presiding at the meeting. All eight regions were represented.

Highlights of the meeting are as follows:

- Minutes of the February 4, 2014 conference call Board meeting were approved as previously distributed.
- Activities of the International Office were reviewed.
- Membership numbers for 2014 were reviewed, showing a loss of 72 members this year, and a total decline in membership over the past 11 years of 1,003 members.
- The performance of investments was reviewed, with a reported return of 7.8% for the year to date on IPPS investments. The Treasurer suggested the investments be moved to a non-managed fund to improve the performance.
- The International Editor presented reports regarding publication of Volume 63 (the Proceedings from 2013 conference).
- Also reviewed was the status for Volume 64 and the preliminary estimate of costs to produce that volume.
- The International Editor reported that papers from Volumes 61 and 62 had been prepared in the proper TXT (text) and PDF formats and sent to ISHS for inclusion on the PubHort website.
- Reports from the various Regions, presented by their Directors, were reviewed.
- There was considerable discussion revolving around the findings and recommendations of the Strategic Review Committee, resulting in the Strategic Initiatives adopted by the Board. These initiatives include:

- Review and modify IPPS Board governance, including redefining Position Descriptions for Officers, Directors, Alternate Directors, Regional Secretary-Treasurers, the International Editor, and the International Secretary.
- Develop a new website, to include the Regions' websites. Also, provide compatibility with other types of personal portable devices.
- Develop a graphics template for the Newsletter.
- Review and modify membership categories and dues structure.
- Review and standardize the International Exchange program.
- Pursue Corporate Sponsorships for various International things, like, website, newsletter, International events, and membership publications, not in conflict with sponsors solicited by regions.
- Formalize Regional Secretaries phone meetings and reports of outcomes.
- The recipient of the Award of Honor for 2015 was identified and approved.
- The International Board reviewed its scheduled conference calls for June, August, and October and have a face-to-face director's meeting in Shanghai, China, in November to finalize anything not resolved in the intervening conference calls. The Shanghai venue was selected to gauge interest in creating a Chinese Region, as this area has tremendous membership growth potential. The Directors will meet with local firms and individuals while there.
- The Board discussed the need to adopt a succession plan of Board officers and Chair.
- The Board discussed the next International Tour and International Conference to be held in Tampa, Florida, USA. The Tour will begin on October 3<sup>rd</sup> in southern Louisiana and ending on October 11<sup>th</sup> in Tampa. The Conference will run through October 15<sup>th</sup>.
