



REPORT FROM THE INTERNATIONAL OFFICE – 2015 ACTIVITIES

"The mission of IPPS, with a focus on the global community of those involved in horticultural plant production, is to share knowledge, information, and skills; to provide guidance and support for lifelong career achievements; to increase recognition of the profession; and to maximize the integration of research, education, and horticultural knowledge."

During 2015, the International Board of Directors continued its focus on efforts on how to sustain and grow the organization's membership by providing the services important to the members. Based on a membership survey at the end of 2013, the Strategic Review Committee analyzed and prioritized themes they were seeing that members wanted from the Society. From that effort, the Board moved to develop a new website, adjust membership categories and restructure the International Board and the roles of its Directors to improve its effectiveness. The membership also noted the lack of communication from International.

In its effort to address these concerns, by the end of 2015, a new website was launched, complete with functionality improvements aimed at aiding members to network with one another, research information quickly, be informed of the Society's activities...and be able to access the site by numerous methods, including, smartphones and I pads. Regional websites have been included within the website structure, to create a seamless, easy to navigate, easy to maintain communication tool throughout the Society. The Board has also been reorganized, duties and responsibilities of the directors clearly defined and continuity of leadership improved. Membership category revisions were begun and will continue into 2016, addressing such issues as members not affiliated with any region, follow-up with student members, and exploring new categories, such as, honorary, retired and introductory memberships. Members not affiliated with any region will now be identified as *IPPS International* members, rather than *IPPS-at-large* members.

IPPS is now in its fourth year of utilizing the publishing services of the International Society for Horticultural Science (ISHS) to print and distribute the book and CD forms of the *Proceedings*, while continuing to post all the papers on their PubHort website. IPPS members continued to receive up to one thousand free downloads of papers and over 1400 members arranged to have an account to download papers. The following use of the PubHort website was reported:

*2010: 149 papers downloaded by 41 unique users**
*2011: 252 papers downloaded by 72 unique users**
*2012: 226 papers downloaded by 69 unique users**
*2013: 475 papers downloaded by 120 unique users**
*2014: 977 papers downloaded by 150 unique users**
*2015: 382 papers downloaded by 78 unique users**

The International Board held its annual meeting in conjunction with the International Tour and Regional Conference in Tampa, Florida, in October, and continued to conduct business via telephone conferences during the year.

Volume 64 of the *Combined Proceedings* was completed and distributed to all members in August. Distribution included 628 books and 350 CD's. About 40 libraries around the world continue to purchase copies to keep their collections up to date.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2015 INTERNATIONAL BOARD MEETING

On October 6 and 10, 2015, the International Board of Directors met in Biloxi, Mississippi, and in Tampa, Florida, USA, with David Cliffe presiding. All eight regions were represented.

Highlights of the meeting are as follows:

- Minutes of the July 7, 2015 conference call Board meeting were approved as previously distributed.
- Activities of the International Office were reviewed.
- Membership numbers for 2015 were reviewed, showing an increase of 32 members this year, although there was a further decline in paying memberships, continuing the trend of the past 12 years.
- The Finance Committee was tasked to evaluate the investment strategy and recommended moving the funds to an indexed account. An Investment Committee was established in December to explore and provided recommendations on this issue to the Board.
- The International Editor reported publication of Volume 65 (the Proceedings from 2014 conference) were on target and would be printed by ISHS for the same cost as 2015. Future International papers will be published as in past: submitted, reviewed, and uploaded to website.
- Reports from the various Regions were provided.

- Progress on the implementation of the Strategic Initiatives adopted by the Board in 2014 was discussed at length. These initiatives include:
 - *Review and modify IPPS Board governance, including redefining Position Descriptions for Officers, Directors, Alternate Directors, Regional Secretary-Treasurers, the International Editor, and the International Secretary.* Position responsibilities and duties were updated and adopted.
 - *Develop a new website, to include the Regions' websites, while providing compatibility with other types of personal portable devices.* The new website was demonstrated and features reviewed in detail. Launch was approved. Website administration will be handled by the International Secretary.
 - *Develop a graphics template for the Newsletter.* The template was completed and presented to the Board. A newsletter editor and a newsletter publisher were appointed to insure quarterly issuance.
 - *Review and modify membership categories and dues structure.* This will be an on-going discussion in 2016. The Board approved a membership fee increase of US\$3 beginning in 2017 to cover the increasing cost per member. Members who want books will also see an increase, to US\$125, while members who order CDs will increase to US\$100. CD publication will cease after Volume 66 of the Proceedings.
 - *Review and standardize the International Exchange program.* Discussions were begun on this item and will continue in 2016.
 - *Pursue Corporate Sponsorships for various International things, like, website, newsletter, International events, and membership publications, not in conflict with sponsors solicited by regions.* The Strategic Committee will establish protocols to observe with regions when soliciting for sponsorships at the International level.
- The Board discussed the next International Tour and International Conference to be held in New Zealand. The Tour will begin on April 10th in Christchurch and end on April 21th in Christchurch. The Conference will run through April 24th.
