



REPORT FROM THE INTERNATIONAL OFFICE – 2016 ACTIVITIES

"The mission of IPPS, with a focus on the global community of those involved in horticultural plant production, is to share knowledge, information, and skills; to provide guidance and support for lifelong career achievements; to increase recognition of the profession; and to maximize the integration of research, education, and horticultural knowledge."

During 2016, the International Board of Directors tackled functionality improvements desired for the new website, particularly, the on-line payment application and site editing procedures. By the end of the year, the payment app was revised and web editing instruction for the regional secretaries was underway.

The Board has discussed in great depth the roles and responsibilities the Society needs and desires to fulfill the expectations for each support staff position. This endeavor will continue into early 2017, as part of this reorganization effort, the Board plans to restructure duties and responsibilities for the International Secretary, the International Editor, the Regional Secretaries, Regional Editors and any other support staff positions identified.

Several regions have offered the recently-implemented introductory membership rate, with new members receiving a one-year 50% discount on International dues. Other membership issues, such as members not affiliated with any region, follow-up with student members, and exploring new membership categories, such as, honorary, retired and memberships continue to be discussed.

Special emphasis has been placed on sponsorship for the International level. Guidelines and sponsorship levels have been developed to aid the Society in soliciting sponsorships from internationally-active corporations.

IPPS is now in its fifth year of utilizing the publishing services of the International Society for Horticultural Science (ISHS) to print and distribute the book and CD forms of the *Proceedings*, while continuing to post all the papers on its PubHort website and the new IPPS website. The production costs for the books and CDs have remained constant for the past few years but will increase in 2017. IPPS members continued to receive up to one thousand free downloads of papers and over 1400 members arranged to have an account to download papers. Papers are now available on the IPPS website and a corresponding reduction of members utilizing the PubHort website has occurred as a result. The following use of PubHort was reported:

- 2010: 259 papers downloaded by 41 unique users*
- 2011: 452 papers downloaded by 72 unique users*
- 2012: 370 papers downloaded by 69 unique users*
- 2013: 685 papers downloaded by 120 unique users*
- 2014: 977 papers downloaded by 150 unique users*
- 2015: 774 papers downloaded by 78 unique users*
- 2016: 246 papers downloaded by 77 unique users**

*these could be IPPS members or others downloading papers
** in 2016, 140 papers were downloaded by 23 different IPPS members

The International Board held its annual meeting in conjunction with the International Tour and Regional Conference in Te Anau and Christchurch, New Zealand, in April, and continued to conduct business via telephone conference meetings during the year.

Volume 65 of the *Combined Proceedings* was printed and distributed to almost all members by the end of December. Distribution included 625 books and 261 CD's. About 40 libraries around the world continue to purchase book and CDs to keep their collections up to date.

Overall membership in IPPS decreased by 1.7% in 2016, with regions reporting membership levels as of December 1, 2016, as follows:

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2016 INTERNATIONAL BOARD MEETING

On April 17 and 21, 2016, the International Board of Directors met in Te Anau, New Zealand, and in Christchurch, New Zealand, with Alan Jones, Chairman, presiding. All eight regions were represented, along with a representative for the proposed China Region.

Highlights of the meeting are as follows:

- Minutes of the March 7, 2016 conference call Board meeting were approved as previously distributed.
- Activities of the International Office were reviewed.
- Membership numbers for 2016 were reviewed. Due to the reporting time, membership numbers were incomplete with a marked reduction of renewals noted. This mostly due to issues encountered with the new website payment application.

- The Investment Committee proposed IPPS move invested funds to an indexed account.
- The International Editor reported publication of Volume 66 (the Proceedings from 2015 conference) was in the queue to be printed by ISHS. Costs to produce the papers in book and CD form are increasing, rising to similar costs as prior to ISHS involvement.
- Reports from the various Regions were provided and reviewed.
- Reports from the various Committees were provided and reviewed.
- The Strategy Committee advanced three new initiatives for the Board to consider, reporting that the initiatives from 2014 have been implemented:
 - *Insure the International organization is structured correctly.*
 - *Evaluate the functional requirements for the International Office.*
 - *Establish a process for succession planning.*
