A new website committee was formed and will include Brie Arthur, David Sanford, and Antony Toledo, along with the Executive Director. This committee will assist the Executive Director with small decisions and issues with the website and present proposals for Board approval for larger projects with the website.

IV. Southern Africa International Tour

A PowerPoint presentation was sent out for the Tour and information will be uploaded by South Africa to the website soon. All board members were invited to the conference, especially to present new technology, techniques to run large nurseries, etc.

V. Treasurer's Report

The Investment Committee voted to move extra money from the checking account into the Vanguard Investments, which allowed us to reach over \$300,000 in the accounts. The committee will rebalance the percentages for holdings soon.

One sponsor chose not to re-sponsor this year but may join back in next year. All other sponsorships have remained the same and checks have been received and dispersed.

Discussion regarding whether International should assist regions in the case of an International Tour being cancelled due to pandemics, wars, natural disasters, etc. International has a sufficient monetary reserve that the Board has stated during the meeting that they are willing to provide support if an International Tour has to be cancelled due to extreme circumstances after deposits were submitted. Each would be decided on a case by case basis.

The International Office explained that International by-laws state that International will pay for airfare for the International Delegate for the International Tour. Tony Van der Staay proposed that we only pay International Delegate for coach airfare. Seconded by David Sanford. Unanimously approved.

VI. Editor's Report

The editor reported there were more papers and regions represented than previously with a total of 56 papers, 397 pages compared to 35 papers and 241 pages in 2022.

Each region needs an editor who submits papers within two months of their Annual Conference. Encourage regions to submit for the International Editor to edit and return for author confirmation.

The Board needs to decide whether to continue with Curran Publishing, whether to pay for DOI through Curran, and how to make our Proceedings papers more visible through online searches.

Action Item: Curran Publishing contract; DOI through Curran (or other options through our website company)

VII. Regional Directors Reports

VIII. Committee Reports

a. Education Committee

The Education Committee met to discuss the best way for International to support regions who are hosting the International Tour in regards to the exchange recipients.

The committee proposed that International pay for the shorttour for the respective exchange student each year. This amount who change each year but is potentially easier than reimbursing receipts and can be budgeted for by International.

Laura Miller motioned that International pay for the short tour for the International Tour for the respective exchange participant each year. Seconded by Jason Myburgh. Motion unanimously approved.

IX. Other Reports

Southern Region of North America is going to have a strategic planning session and membership drive for 2024. Several other regions have been working on strategic planning and/or membership drives.

China and India discussion showed that there is still potential but neither has moved forward at this point or has willing representation on the Board yet.

X. Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at 5:25 PM. The next meeting will be in person in October during the International Tour.

Investment Committee Report

International Plant Propagator's Society Investment Committee Report

Investment Allocation: The committee makes allocation adjustments as needed to maintain Investment Policy recommendations. On May 31, 2023, the profile was apportioned with 70% invested in three growth and income-producing equity index funds: Vanguard Growth & Samp; Income Fund, Vanguard Total Stock Mkt. Index and Vanguard Total International Stock Index Fund, and two fixed asset funds with 13.2% in Bonds and 16.8% in Short Term Reserves.

Performance:

Vanguard Growth & Drome Fund YTD -6.40% Vanguard Total Stock Mkt. Index Fund YTD + 2.13% Vanguard Total INTL Stock Index Admiral YTD -1.14% Vanguard Total Bond Mkt. Index Fund YTD - 4.20% Vanguard Federal Money Mkt. Fund YTD + .09% S&P 500 Index YTD +11.15%

Dividends received YTD \$1746.11

Committee Actions and Evaluations:

Executive Director Katie McDavid reported during the February 16th Zoom meeting that there were no large upcoming expenditures that would require a withdrawal of funds from the Investment account. Katie also reported that the funds in the checking account were greater than the anticipated needs of the Society for the coming year. During the May 9 th meeting the committee agreed to transfer \$44,000 from the bank checking account into the Vanguard investment account. The committee will balance the portfolio's targeted allocations at our next meeting. It was also noted that the committee does not make investment decisions based on actual or anticipated short-term market fluctuations, reaffirming a three-to-five-year focus in making investment decisions.

Committee recommendations:

With the appointment of David Cliff following last year's June 2022 board meeting, the committee is now composed of members with staggered terms, which will help assure stability as longer serving members rotate off. However, it should be noted that two current committee members are serving in their second term, so new committee members need to be recruited.
