I. Welcome and Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 4:40 PM by the Chairman.

II. Approval of Minutes

Motion to approve minutes from October 23, 2023 was presented and approved unanimously.

The Executive Office reviewed the actions items:

- i. Name Change Committee will meet in early 2024
- ii. Google Analytics for Students on website being created by the web developer using the monthly maintenance hours so no additional costs to the organization
- iii. Strategic Planning Committee will meet in early 2024; regions NEED to send any strategic planning notes, surveys, etc. to the Executive Office as soon as possible to utilize during the International Strategic Planning
- iv. Chairman and Treasurer nominations to be discussed later

III. International Tour Report

The Southern Africa delegate and alternate delegate presented information regarding the upcoming International Tour. There are 15 short tour, 25 conference, and 10 long tour paid registrants at this time. Only one Board member has registered at this point.

A motion was presented to approve \$6,400 USD International funds for emergency use (such as masks, covid tests, extra vehicles for covid-positive attendees, etc.) during the Southern Africa tour based on the covid situation that occurred during the 2023 Southern Region of NA tour. It was seconded and unanimously approved.

A discussion was had regarding whether there should be a formal protocol for Covid for International Tours; however, it was decided that sick people should simply avoid others and that covid isn't the only illness that could potentially spread during bus tours.

A motion was made for the International funds to pay up to \$500 USD for an International Sponsor item for the Southern Africa tour, similar to the notebook from the SRNA tour. The motion was seconded and unanimously approved.

IV. Treasurer's Report

There was a 17% increase in membership from 2022 to 2023. This helped the 2023 budget. Almost all flight reimbursements have been paid for Board Delegates for the 2023 International Tour.

A motion was presented to approve payments (totaling \$1,380.11) to individuals who had covid-related expenses from the 2023 Southern Region of NA tour. It was seconded and unanimously approved. The Executive Director will send the reimbursement checks shortly.

V. Editor's Report

There are currently 2 Southern Africa, 7 New Zealand, 6 Japan, and 10 Australia Region papers submitted for the Proceedings. There is concern that the Eastern Region may not be able to submit as many reports as in the past due to not filling their editor position with an individual. However, the Proceedings is currently on pace to be back to pre-Covid levels this year.

VI. Executive Director's Report

The Executive Director stated that there were no additional nominations for the Chairman position received, beyond Tom Saunders. A motion was made for Tom Saunders to become the new Chairman. It was seconded and unanimously approved.

With Tom Saunders moving into the Chairman position, a new treasurer will be needed. A comment was raised regarding whether a treasurer is still needed for the organization. Many of the IPPS regions with paid management have a joint secretary/treasurer rather than two separate positions. Additionally, as an officer of the Board, International policies state that officers travel to the International Tour(s) would be comped. The Executive Director stated that at the moment, there is an outside CPA/Accountant that reconciles and double checks the finances, that the Executive Director is the only one who writes and sees the checks and bills, and that the finance committee has a good oversight on the finances and investment plans.

A discussion was held that stated that there may still be a need for a treasurer as an additional member of the Executive Committee for decisions and ideas; however, based on the Executive Director's comments, the position may be better titled as assistant chairman or other name. The Board will discuss options for names as well as the treasurer's position's duties. It was also raised that the International Editor should be considered for the Executive Committee as well.

A comment was made regarding the lack of updated documents within the organization, with the Executive Director stating that updating the documents regularly may become part of the strategic plan.

VII. Regional Directors Reports

VIII. Other Comments

Several members from the Japan Region visited New Zealand in the past few weeks to visit a colleague and have a small tour. It was a successful trip, although the Japan Region is still insistent upon dissolving the region at the end of 2024.

A discussion was raised regarding whether there is anything else that can be done to assist the Japan Region, whether their members can and will join another region (likely the New Zealand Region), whether New Zealand could extend their region to include Japan, and whether there is potential in the IPPS guidelines for the region to be suspended for a period of time, rather than fully dissolve (if the region believes there could be further interest in the future).

Tim Lawrance-Owen stated his appreciation as Chairman as this was his last meeting. Several comments were made regarding his wonderful leadership through a very difficult several years.

IX. Adjournment and Future Meetings

A request was made for the meetings to be moved earlier in the day, specifically for South Africa delegates. Upcoming meetings are as follows (in Eastern US Time):
